# **EDITORIAL PROCESS**

- 1 Gather your work, make a selection; what should be there, what to eliminate
- 2 Arrange work into sections; write short descriptions, determine order and structure; sketch!
- Write (larger) text parts; explain about yourself, your work, interests etc., draw multiple base-designs. First sketch (on paper), after that on screen.




pages: accessible via menu


