





STEPS 4-6

EDITORIAL PROCESS

Choose a base design, create test pages which contain text and images.

Re-group your work, re-consider your design and rewrite texts.

Create the site, refine design and texts.



CREATE THE SITE, REFINE DESIGN AND TEXTS

- Build site
 - Create (or use) a template based on design
 - Add pages based on template
- Refine
 - Design
 - Content (texts, images, video's...)
- Test

ASSIGNMENT "ADD CONTENT"

ADD CONTENT TO SHOWCASE PORTFOLIO

Do:

Who made this? Where and when was it made? What is its purpose? Where was it made for? Why is this on your site? ...


On your Blog:

Design activity this week: further add personal style to the design of your site/theme. Write (larger) text parts. Improve details.


