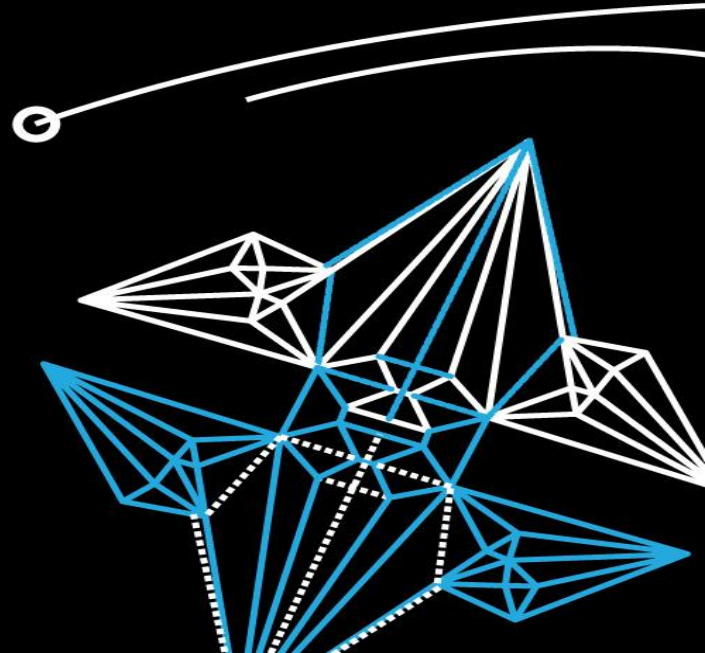
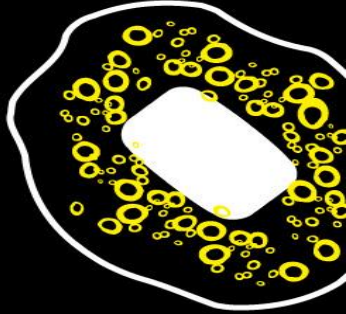

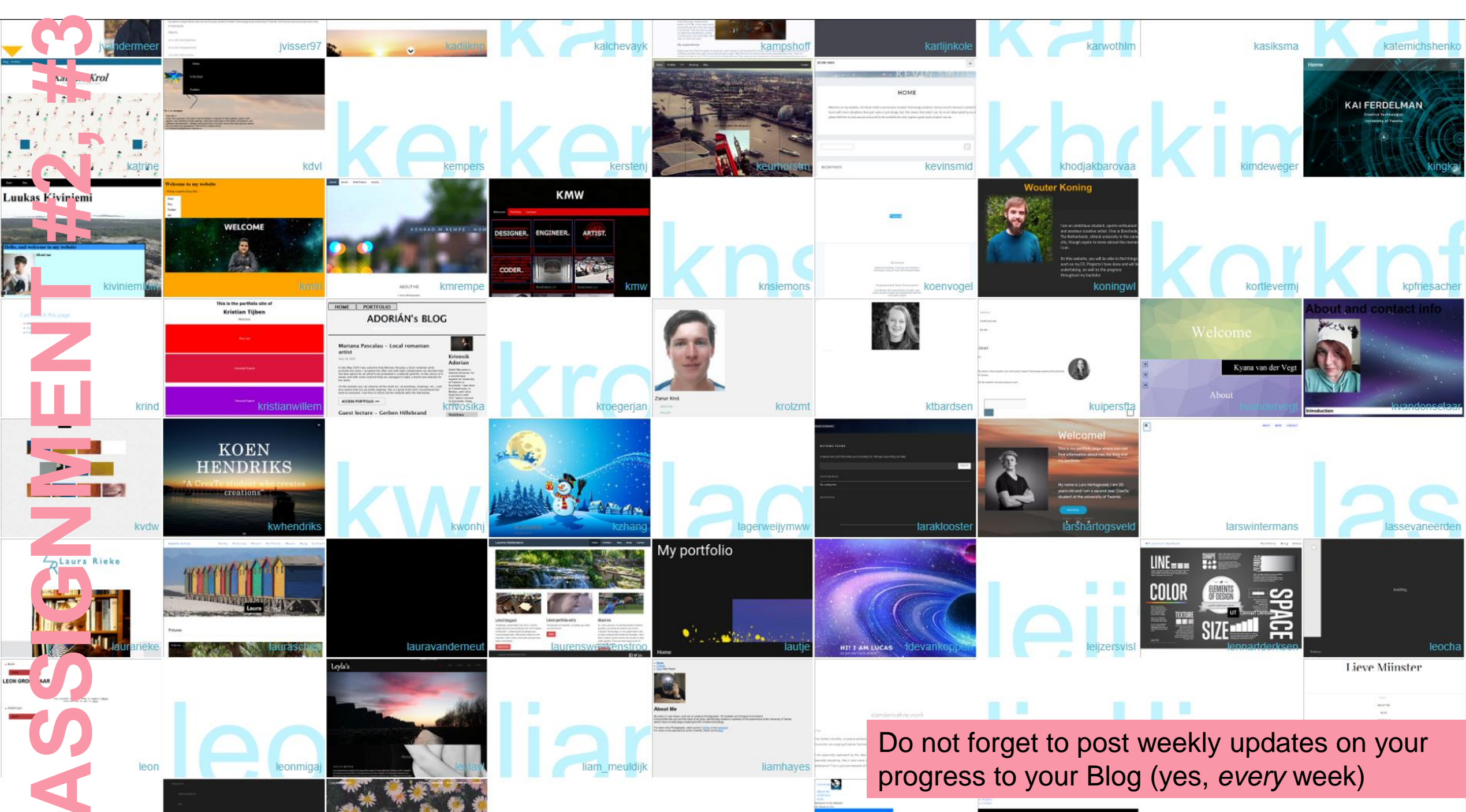

### Web Technology Assignment 3: "Create Portfolio"

Create a (first) page for the Showcase Portfolio and display a first piece of work at that page. Add a menu or other navigation

Your site should contain multiple pages with a clear navigation structure (eg. menu).

At least a Blog and a (start of a) Showcase Portfolio should be there and accessible from the main page (homepage). Blog p

Add two posts to your Blog:

1. Review a (random) website, state it's name, include a link to the site, describe its purpose in 3 sentences and name 5 st
2. Add a second post with an update on your progress\*\* for the Video Project of We Create Identity to your Blog.

Add styling to the first Blog post, which makes the two lists of strong and weak point align next to each other (if the screen

\*\* 'progress' means a description of actual work and/or results should be presented. Phrases like 'no progress made' or 'not be: a subject, a theme, ideas/design sketches of scenes, a script, sketches of a story board.

This is for you to verify you did everything for this assignment, it will not send anything to eg. the lecturer or anyone else. There is no guarantee you will pass this assignment if you check-off all items. **How to use this:** First, read the assignment description, then do the assignment, after this, use this checklist.

- ☐ Your site has at least two pages or sections: a Showcase Portfolio and a Blog
- ☐ The pages share a common stylesheet or template (external stylesheet), or if you use WordPress, a theme
- ☐ The Showcase Portfolio displays a first piece of work
- ☐ The first piece of work shown on the Showcase Portfolio has at least a title, description and a date (when it was made or published)
- ☐ Your site has a menu or some kind of navigation element to navigate between Blog and Portfolio
- ☐ Blog posts are clearly separated, have a clear title and a date
- ☐ A Blog post with the review of a (random) website has been added
- ☐ The post includes a link to the reviewed site, describes its purpose in 3 sentences and names 5 strong and 5 weak points of that site
- ☐ The two lists with strong and weak point align next to each other (if the screen size allows)
- ☐ For the two lists, an HTML list element is used
- ☐ A Blog post with an update on your progress for the Video Project of We Create Identity has been added


## ASSIGNMENT "ADD CONTENT"

### ADD CONTENT TO SHOWCASE PORTFOLIO

---

*Do:*

- Update your Showcase Portfolio with another piece of your work. Make sure all items in the portfolio have a short description and context-information (who/where/when/what/why)
- Show your artistic skills by adding a personal touch to the design of your site (eg. by modification of the theme or stylesheet)



Who made this? Where and when was it made?  
What is its purpose?  
Where was it made for?  
Why is this on your site? ...

*On your Blog:*

1. Post an announcement on your Blog about the second piece of work in the Showcase Portfolio including a link to that piece
2. Post a second post in which you describe how you realized your 'personal touch' of the design in the theme/stylesheet (give 2 examples, explain code).
